Resolution 089-22: Introduced by Council as a Whole: A Resolution certifying to the Board of Elections the issue of a 3 Mill renewal tax levy for parks and recreation purposes pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19(H) for a period of five years to be voted upon by the electors of the City of Alliance; and declaring an emergency.

Second Readings:

Ordinance No. 003-23: Introduced by: Cherry: An Ordinance appropriating funds and authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into contract(s) with a roofing contractor for the purpose of replacing the roof

on the Alliance Senior Center, and renovating the cupola, but at a cost not to exceed \$110,000.00; and declaring an emergency.

New Business:

Ordinance 004-23: Introduced by Lohnes: An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids for various types of insurance for its comprehensive municipal liability coverage as set forth in this ordinance for up to a three year period and enter into a contract or contracts with the lowest and best bidder, with an optional three year extension at the City's sole discretion, and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance 005-23: Introduced by Cherry: An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to accept a Grant from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) for \$250,000.00 for the purpose of making improvements to the Alliance Park System, and to enter into a contract with ODNR as required; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance No. 006-23: Introduced by: Cherry: An Ordinance appropriating funds and authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into contracts at the lowest and best prices for the purpose of purchasing skatepark equipment and constructing a pump track at Memorial Park through the cooperative purchasing programs, by advertising for bids, or by soliciting quotes; and declaring an emergency.

Resolution No. 007-23: Introduced by: Lohnes: A Resolution authorizing the sale, by internet auction during calendar year 2023, of City owned personal property which is not needed for public use or which is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired.

Ordinance No. 008-23: Introduced by: Edwards: An Ordinance amending the Sanitary Sewer Services charges contained in Ordinance 34-04 as amended by Ordinances 172-04, 105-08, 107-11, 76-14, 5-20, 5-21, 3-22, and the Alliance Codified Ordinance section 911.931; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance No. 009-23: Introduced by: Council as a Whole: An Ordinance amending Ordinance 7-91, 161-99, 30-15, and 23-20 Wages, Salaries, and work benefits for employees of the City of Alliance who are not represented by a Collective Bargaining Agreement; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance No. 010-23: Introduced by: Edwards: An Ordinance appropriating funds and authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract with Aecom to perform a critical flood study at a cost not to exceed 70,000.00; and declaring an emergency.

Old Business:

Ordinance 80-20: Introduced by Bugara: An Ordinance vacating all of a twenty (20) foot alley bounded on the North by Prospect Street; bounded on the South by part of a 13102 in the City of Alliance, County of Stark and State of Ohio. amending

Ordinance 81-20: Introduced by Bugara: An Ordinance vacating all of a twenty (20) foot alley bounded on the North by Norfolk Southern Railroad; bounded on the South by Prospect Street; bounded on the East by part of lot 482; and bounded on the West by lot 2094 in the City of Alliance, County of Stark and State of Ohio.

Ordinance 82-20: Introduced by Bugara: An Ordinance vacating all of a twenty (20) foot alley bounded on the North by a twenty (20) foot alley; bounded on the South by lot 11829; bounded on the East by part of lot 231; and bounded on the West by lot 221 in the City of Alliance, County of Stark and State of Ohio.

Ordinance 86-21S: Introduced by Council as a Whole: An Ordinance affirming the conditions as set forth in Ordinances 23-20 and 37-20; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance 071-22: Introduced by Madison: An Ordinance to enact Section 1501.15 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Alliance authorizing the Fire Chief to establish fire lanes on public and private property, prohibiting the obstruction of a fire lane or the parking of a vehicle in a fire lane, and providing for the removal of obstructions and the removal and impoundment of parked vehicles; and declaring an emergency.
