

Claims Board Committee Minutes of

June 12, 2024 (Approved June 27, 2024)

Present: Councilman Ed Lohnes, Councilwoman Jenn Kiko, Councilman Kris Bugara, CSSD Mike Dreger, Desirae Roberts, Sherry Harp and Morgan Huxtable.

5:22pm: Chairman Lohnes Called the meeting to order and read the public notice. First order of business as to have the minutes of June 3, 2024 approved: Motion was made, seconded and all in favor – notes approved without any corrections or revisions.

Lohnes then addressed the attendees by reviewing the documentation from the March 7th, 8th, and 20th. He asked about the 4" to 6" of sewage on the 20th. Ms. Roberts said it passively drained after the visit by the city. Lohnes asked if the lateral sewer pipe was clogged and needed snaked? Answer: No

5:40pm: Bugara and Dreger discussed the events of March 20th, ending with Bugara requesting more documentation for clarity. Dreger replied that he would provide a more detailed account. Lohnes added that the call on the 220th came in at 11:06am, dispatched at 11:08am and workers arrived at 11:09am.

5:44pm: Kiko asked if her plumber came out a second time, referring to March 20th. Answer: No, it started to recede on its own. Reviewed the March 7th & 8th incident with Ms. Roberts. Ms. Roberts said she was told the main was clogged to the lift station. Kiko: is there anything to ensure that nothing else will go wrong? Answer: Ms. Roberts, no, then she informed the committee that a backflow preventor is being installed and that her line insurance company is paying for the work.

5:56pm: Lohnes stated that there was no more additional damage done on the 20th because all the damage occurred on the first backup on the 7th and 8th. Ms. Roberts response was that is true but that the 20th would have resulted in the same damage due to the depth of backup being 4" to 6".

5:58pm: Dreger stated that any questions can be emailed to him. Kiko asked why 10 hrs. on the work order for March 20th? Dreger: they were not present for 10 hours and that he will get clarity.

6:00pm: Lohnes stated that an additional meeting will be required to answer the questions concerning the March 20th incident. He asked for motion to adjourn, seconded, all in favor, meeting was adjourned.
