Ordinance No. 066-23: Introduced by: Madison: An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into an exclusive contract for emergency medical and ambulance transport services within the City of Alliance; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance No. 067-23: Introduced by: Lohnes: An Ordinance approving the purchase of enhanced financial software by the Alliance City Auditor's Office, but at a cost not to exceed \$38,000; and declaring an emergency.
