New Business:

Ordinance No. 072-23: Introduced by: Madison: An Ordinance appropriating funds and authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to purchase two new police cruisers and a SRT van through cooperative purchasing programs or to advertise for bids if required and enter into contracts at the lowest and best prices to purchase the vehicles and items necessary to equip the vehicles, but for a cost not to exceed \$186,000.00 in any case; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance No. 073-23: Introduced by: Madison: An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to purchase twenty new body cameras for the police department, but for a cost not to exceed \$26,000.00 in any case; and declaring an emergency.
