An ordinance fixing the salary of certain employees at the Alliance City Hospital was read the first time and referred to the Finance Committee for immediate action.

On motion of Davis seconded by Ryan, council referred back to the fourth order of business, reports of standing committees.

The Finance committee submitted their report recommending the passage of Ordinance No. 101-E.

The report of the committee was agreed to.

Motion to suspend rules on Ord. 101-E lost.

The question being on the suspension of the rules, the yeas and nays were taken and resulted yeas 3, nays 4. Those who voted in the affirmative were Messrs. Davis, Ryan, and Trott. Those who voted in the negative were Messrs. Akins, McCredie, Miller and Riggs. So the motion not having received the necessary three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$) vote of the members elected thereto, was lost.

Miller moved seconded by Davis that when we adjourn we adjourn to meet next Monday Evening, which motion was agreed to.
