

MONDAY EVENING MARCH 19th, 1923.

Council met in regular session with President Barnard in the chair.

The roll being called, the following members answered to their names: Messrs. Akins, Davis, McCredie, Riggs, Ryan, and Trott. Present 6, absent 1.

The minutes of the previous meetings were read and approved.

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The following petition was presented to council and referred to the Service Director, City Solicitor, and Streets and Alleys Committee.

PETITION FOR IMPROVEMENT

NOTE: This petition should be signed in ink by the owner or owners of the lots abutting on the street, that is, each person in whose name the title to the property is recorded, should sign, and the signer set up not the house number but the lot number and frontage of the same.

To the Council of the City of Alliance, State of Ohio:

Gentlemen:

We, the undersigned, being the owners of the number of feet of property set opposite our names below and being two-thirds (2/3) or more in interest of the owners of property abutting on East Main Street, between Union Avenue and Mechanic Avenue hereby respectfully petition your honorable board to pass the necessary legislation therefor and to improve said street between the points aforesaid by repaving the old portion of said street to the width of forty-eight (48) feet and by widening said street ten (10) feet so as to make the paved portion of said street after same has been widened fifty-eight (58) feet wide, constructing sewers and the necessary underground work for the future White Way construction and that the cost of said improvement shall be assessed by the foot-front plan upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said East Main Street between the points aforesaid in the following manner, to-wit:

First - On all new construction consisting of sewers the grading, draining and curbing of the new portion of said street consisting of ten (10) feet and the construction of the necessary underground work for the future White Way - the entire cost of same shall be paid by the property owners, excepting two (2) percent thereof and the cost of intersections in such new construction.

Second - On all repaving said property owners agree to pay fifty (50) percent of the entire cost of said improvement including street intersections and that same shall be assessed against their said property by the foot-front plan.

And the undersigned and each of them consent and request that said assessments be levied and collected without reference to the value of the property of the subscribers hereto and waive all benefits of any statute limiting assessments or reassessments and hereby agree to pay the assessments as levied on their respective properties and waive all errors and technicalities that may arise in connection with said improvements and agree to pay said assessments as hereinbefore stated. Said assessments to be payable in twenty (20) semi-annual installments proportioned to the whole assessment or in cash at the option of the owner of the property assessed in the manner provided by law for the levy and collection of assessments.
