To the Honorable City Council
of the City of Alliance, O
Gentlemen
Referring to the application of the
A. A. Short Line Railway Company
for the establishment of a route for a
Street Railway over certain streets in the
city of Alliance bearing date of April
14th 1911 as per blue print attached
thereto we wish to report that we have
carefully examined said application and
route and we would recommend the
approval of the route as submitted
on the condition that the franchise
to be granted in connection therewith
shall provide that whenever a subway
shall be constructed at Hester Ave. and
the S.E.A. W.R.R. the said A. A. Short
Line Railway Co. shall pay one

of the city's portion of the cost of said subway.

We would further recommend that a franchise for said Railway be prepared under the direction of the City Solicitor and submitted to this council
