Whereas, we the undersigned owners of real estate located outside the city of Alliance O. on what is known as the extension of West Cambridge St. a distance of about 400 feet, and the extension of West Summit St. a distance of about 375 feet, to the boulevard running parallel with Rockwell Avenue, in said city, and within four (4) miles of said city, and

Whereas, said undersigned are desirous of obtaining from the City of Alliance O. permission for an extension of water from the water works of said city, through a main or mains, pipe or pipes to be laid by said undersigned, free of all costs or expense to said city, and upon the terms and conditions of Ordinance No 1554, passed November 25th 1912, entitled, "An ordinance to provide for the extension of water service beyond the city of Alliance, Ohio."

Therefore, We the undersigned, each for himself or itself hereby ask permission of your honorable body, that permission may be granted said undersigned, under the terms and condition of said Ordinance No 1554 to connect a main or mains with nearest most convenient water main thereof and upon granting to us such request we and each of us acknowledge ourselves bound by each and all the terms, stipulations and condition of said Ordinance.
