Consideration of Ordinances and Resolutions.

Res. No. 1637

Mr Gubb. Declaring it necessary to improve South Freedom Avenue between South lot line College Street and North lot line State Street by grading was read the second time.

Res. No 1651.

Mr Voss. To issue a certificate of indebtedness of the City of Alliance, State of Ohio to provide for current expenses in the water Department was read the first time.

The question being on the adoption of the resolution.

The Yeas and Nays were taken and resulted Yeas. 4 Nays 0.

So the resolution was passed.

Ord No. 1652.

Mr. An ordinance to levy special assessment for the improvement of Sanitary Sewer No 138. from a point at the center of the intersection of Warren Street in the City of Alliance Ohio and Rockhill Road to and connect with Sewer 5. at a point on Vine Street and the center of the first alley east of Lincoln Avenue was read the first time.

Ord No. 1655.

Mr Barnard To appropriate property for providing for a supply of water for the City of Alliance, Ohio and its inhabitants by providing a reservoir site and constructing thereon a reservoir in Know Township, Columbiana County. O was read the first time.

Ord. No. 1654

To levy special assessments for the construction of sidewalks was read the first time.

Ord No 1653.

To levy special assessments for the construction of Sewer. Water Connections was read the first time.

Ord No 1644

Mr Lower, An ordinance to accept the Crescent Boulevard Allotment, in the W. M. Ellett Addition to the city of Alliance, O. was read the first time.

The following article of agreement was read,

Agreement

In consideration of the city council of the city of Alliance approving and accepting the dedication of the streets and alleys of the plat of the Crescent Boulevard Allotment in the W. M. Ellett addition to the city of Alliance, O.

Ordinance No 1644 I hereby agree to grade all the streets - alleys and lay all sidewalks in said addition in full of all expenses to the city of Alliance, Ohio.
