Ord. No. 1672

Mr. Barnard To grant leave to M. Mutch,
to lay a switch across what is known as
Car Alley, between Freedom and Seneca
Avenues in the city of Alliance, at
grade, from what is known the
Morgan Switch of The L. S. M. S. Ry.
was read the second time.

Ord No. 1670

Mr. Yarnum - An ordinance to levy special assessments for the improvement of a Sanitary sewer from a point at the center of intersection of West Main Street in the City of Alliance, Ohio, and Rockhill Road to and connect with Sewer 5 at a point on Vine Street and the center of the first alley east of Lincoln Avenue by constructing Sanitary Sewer No. 138 was read the second time.

Res. No. 1668

Whereas, the Official Board of the Union Avenue M. E. Church, Union Avenue, Alliance, Ohio, have petitioned council for electric lights on said Union Avenue, and in front of said Church, and Whereas, said Official Board have proposed to erect one five lamp steel post, two three lamp steel posts at said place, free of cost and expense to the City of Alliance, on condition that said city will furnish the necessary current of electricity to burn in such lamps, free of cost and expense to said Official Board of said Union Avenue, M. E. Church was read the second time.

Ord No. 1667

Mr. Barnard - To prohibit the digging of ditches or other excavation in the streets, alleys and public places in the city of Alliance, Ohio, without first giving notice to the Fire Department was read the second time.

Ord No. 1683

Mr. Yarnum - To authorize the Director of Public Service of the City of Alliance, Ohio to enter into a contract for lighting the streets and alleys, avenues, public grounds, and public buildings was read the second time.

Ord. No. 1684

Mr. Yarnum. An ordinance regulating the maximum price to be charged for electric light by any person, persons, firm or corporation in the City of Alliance, State of Ohio, and repealing all prior ordinances in conflict herewith was read the second time.

Ord No. 1680

Mr. Yarnum. An ordinance to accept Gagers Plat of Milton Street was read the second time.

The following ordinances and resolutions were introduced.

Res No. 1690.

Mr. Barnard. To issue a certificate of indebtedness of the City of Alliance, State of Ohio, to provide a fund for the purpose of the cost and expense of improving Cherry Avenue between State Street and Harris place by grading was read the first time. Referred to Finance Com.

Res No. 1689.

Mr. Farmer. Declaring it necessary to construct a sewer in the city of Alliance, Ohio, along a portion of what is known as Ryan's Run, was read the first time. Referred to com. on Sewers.

Ord. No. 1688.

Mr. Farmer. To provide for a site upon which to erect a city Hospital, and for the leasing of such hospital after the same has been erected, was read the first time. Referred to com. on Budget, Buildings.

Ord. No. 1687.

Mr. Farmer. To regulate travel of vehicles on the Public Square in the City of Alliance, State of Ohio, was read the first time. Referred to com. on Streets, Alleys.

Res No. 1686.

Mr. Gower. To provide plans and specifications for a new city hall, to be erected in the City of Alliance, Ohio, was read the first time. Referred to com. on Budget, Building.
