Ordinance No. 70-N.

Mr. Burkley

An Ordinance to license billiard rooms, pool rooms and bowling alleys within the City of Alliance, Ohio, and to repeal all conflicting ordinances.

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the council of the City of Alliance, State of Ohio: -

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons, firm, partnership or corporation to operate or conduct a billiard room, pool room or bowling alley, within the City of Alliance, Ohio, for money or other reward without having first obtained a license therefor from the Mayor, provided, however, that no license shall be granted to any person who is not a citizen of the United States. The license fee for a billiard room and pool room shall be as follows:

The license fee for each billiard room, pool room or bowling alley, operated in the City of Alliance, shall be \$12.50 per annum, and, in addition thereto, each and every person, firm, partnership or corporation shall pay a further charge of \$4<sup>00</sup> for each table or alley operated and installed.

It is further understood, and a part of this ordinance, that if any person, firm, partnership or corporation shall operate both a billiard room and bowling alley under the same management and in the same building, then they shall pay but one annual room charge and, in addition thereto, the above annual rates for additional tables & alleys.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of Alliance, Ohio, shall have the right and authority to revoke any license issued by virtue of this ordinance at any time that said licensee has been convicted of a crime or misdemeanor under the laws of the State of Ohio or the ordinances of the City of Alliance.

Section 3. That all ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent or in conflict herewith, be, and the same are, hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 3. That all ordinances, or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith, be, and the same are, hereby repealed.

Section 4. That the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
