This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and after the 15<sup>th</sup> day of November A. D. 1854.

Resolved, That the law requiring the reading of each ordinance on different days, be suspended for the purpose of passing the above ordinance against profane swearing, passed by three fourths of Council

The ordinance on its final passage on motion it was voted Yeas 5, nays 0, the vote stood Yeas Messrs Hester, Hanger, Chapman, Pierce and Woodworth, Nays none.

An Ordinance: Granting discretionary power.

Be it ordained, by the Town Council of Alliance, That the Mayor, (or in case of his absence) The Council, shall have power to release prisoners, when deemed necessary.

Resolved, That the law requiring the reading of each ordinance on three different days be suspended for the purpose of passing the above Ordinance, passed by three fourths of Council.

On its final passage on motion it was voted Yeas 5 nays 0. The vote stood Yeas Messrs Hester, Hanger, Chapman, Pierce, and Woodworth Nays none.

Resolved, That the recorder be instructed to get the Ordinance Printed in the Alliance Ledger at as low a rate as possible and have it charged to the Incorporation.

The council met by a call by the mayor there being a Council present they proceeded to business.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of Alliance That it shall be the duty of the Mayor to call a meeting of the Council whenever he thinks it necessary. And on the refusal of any of the Council to attend at the appointed time, without a reasonable excuse it shall be the duty of the Mayor to find said person in any sum not less than twenty five cents nor more than one dollar. Passed by three fourths of Council.
