Monday eve October 2. 1876

Council convened in regular session.

Mayer Barnaby being absent, on motion W.E. Strong was chosen Chairman.

Roll called; Members Present: Seck, Gray, Ickes & Strong Absent: Vincent.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved

By permission Elisha Pickett addressed the Council, complaining of certain bills for putting down Sidewalks on Broadway.

Clerk also stated that similar complaints had been made by Hovey Hoover and Frank Kellogg.

Statement by P.B. Garland of Lumber and Spikes for month of September 1876 was read & on motion ordered filed and the Sidewalk Committee requested hereafter to include in said Statement a detailed account where the lumber and spikes were used and what work had been performed.
