

of examining at any proper time his or her premises
such person or persons so offending shall be deemed guilty
of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be fined
in a sum not more than twenty dollars, nor less than five
dollars, at the discretion of the officer having and taking
jurisdiction of said offence.

Sec 4th That if the occupier or occupiers of any lot or part
a lot on which any of the nuisance, here in before enumerated
shall be found, shall refuse, or neglect to remove or abate
the same after having been notified so to do by the Marshal
or any other authorized officer of said town, the Marshal
shall then proceed to remove or abate the same, and the
expense of such removal or abatement shall be paid by the
occupier of the premises on which said nuisance is found
and the amount of such expense shall be in addition to
and included in the same judgment as the fine hereinbefore
provided.

Sec 5th This ordinance shall be in force from and after
the tenth day of June 1855.

On Motion Resolved that the foregoing report be received and
the committee discharged.
