

May 30th 1855

The Town Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance met pursuant to adjournment, all present.

On Motion, the ordinance creating board of Health was ordered to its third Reading, and passed by a unanimous vote.

On Motion the Ordinance to promote health was ordered to its third reading, and passed by a unanimous vote.

On Motion Resolved that Sec 1st of the ordinance creating board of Health be so amended, as to read, until their successors in office are appointed.

The following ordinance was presented and read.

Ordinance to prevent Drunkenness.

Sec 1st Be it ordained by the town Council of the incorporated Village of Alliance, That it shall be unlawful for any person to become intoxicated or found in a state of intoxication within the incorporated limits of the town of Alliance. And every person so found and offending, shall upon Conviction thereof before the Mayor or other officer before whom the same is tried, be fined in any sum not less than two nor more than ten Dollars and the costs of prosecution, or stand committed to jail for any period not to exceed ten days, or both at the discretion of the Court and continue in jail until all fines and costs are paid except released by said incorporated authorities.

Sec 2nd That any person found violating section first of the Ordinance may be arrested by any person without process or charge of Intoxication and taken before the officer having jurisdiction over the same for trial, And it is furthermore made the duty of the Village Marshall, Council, or any one of them, and every good citizen or other person favorable to good order and Sobriety to arrest and bring to trial any person found violating the provisions of this ordinance.

Sec 3rd This ordinance shall be in force on and after June 10th 1855.

The following Resolution was presented, Resolved by the Town Council of the incorporated Village of Alliance that the law requiring the reading of each Ordinance on three different days be suspended to pass an Ordinance to prevent Drunkenness, which carried by a unanimous vote.

On Motion the Ordinance to prevent drunkenness passed by a unanimous vote.

On Motion adjourned to meet on Monday Evening June 4th at 7 O. Clock
