

and encouraging the owner or keeper of any such house or the females who reside therein or resort thereto shall on conviction thereof be fined in any sum not over fifty dollars nor less than five dollars on complaint of any person having knowledge of the same or be imprisoned in the jail of the county not less than five nor over fifty days or both at the discretion of the court.

Sec 4th That any person being the head of a family within the corporate limits who shall hire, harbor, encourage, board, lodge or assist any person knowing such person to be a lewd, lascivious or licentious person either male or female, shall on conviction before the proper officer be fined in any sum not exceeding twenty dollars nor less than five dollars for the first offense, and for every subsequent offense shall be fined in any sum not less than twenty dollars nor more than forty dollars at the discretion of the court.

Sec 5th This ordinance to be in force on and after the 21st day of July 1855.
