

April 16<sup>th</sup> 1856

The Officers Elected of the Incorporated Village of Alliance met at the house of Seth Trunkay and after being sworn according to law proceeded to business

A Bill was presented in favor of Seth Trunkay for taking Enumeration of South in Alliance School District. Amt claimed \$2.50.

The above Bill was accepted and an order granted for the same on the Treasurer

A Bill was presented by A. C. Darger for labor performed on Depot Street. Amt \$8.94

The above Bill was accepted and an order granted on the Treasurer

A Petition was presented signed by John C. Schneider Mrs W. Richard and about ninety other citizens of Alliance praying the Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance to devise means whereby the Drill in front of Mrs Ellerson and John C Schneiders property, might be graded to a suitable grade to render it passible by teams &c.

The above petition was received and Committee of two appointed consisting of Simon Cly. & Alex Joseph who were instructed to view the work and report at the next meeting of the Council

On Motion Seth Trunkay was appointed in addition to the above Committee

On Motion adjourned to meet in one week from this evening

The Town Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance met pursuant to adjournment.

The Recorder being absent, G. W. Keen was appointed Recorder Pro Tem

On Motion of S. Cly. an order was drawn on the Treasurer in favor of E. S. Webb State Treasurer for one Dollar and Seventy Cents for percentage due him

A. C. Darger Moved that the Committee to whom was referred the petition in relation to Mr J. C. Schneiders Drill be retained another week, the Committee not being prepared to report. After some debate the motion was put and lost

G. W. Keen Moved to reconsider the vote, which being adopted, the Motion to retain the Committee was again
