Mr S Cly from the Committee to whom was referred the petition for improving Schneiders Hill reported as follows  
To the Mayor and Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance

Gentlemen,

We the undersigned, your Committee to whom was referred the petition of the Citizens of Alliance asking for an appropriation from your honorable body to grade the hill between Old Williamsport & Freedom and within the incorporated Village of Alliance, beg leave to submit the following report.

1<sup>st</sup>. We find the hill and the road from the foot of the hill to the Bridge in a bad condition

2<sup>nd</sup>. We find a difficulty existing among the owners of the land on either side of the track now used as a highway, as to where the Road should run, which we would recommend to be settled before any labor or money should be expended. To settle this difficulty your Committee would recommend that the middle of the street between the buildings known as the Elbertson House and the Old Gilson Tavern should be taken for the middle of the road on the top of the hill, and the centre of the Bridge across the Mahoning for the centre of the road at the North End, and that the road be made as near straight between the two points as the corner of Mr Schneiders House will permit, which we find about twenty one inches in the street.

In answer to the prayer of the petitioners and to assist the Supervisor in making necessary repairs your Committee would recommend an appropriation of ten dollars to made and that the money be placed
