On Motion the report was received and the Committee discharged

On Motion Resolved that the sum of Ten Dollars be appropriated towards repairing the Hill, known as Schneiders Hill, under the direction of the Supervisor who is hereby instructed to straighten the same as far as practicable between the top of the hill and the Bridge, and that an order be drawn on the treasurer for said amount

On Motion Resolved there be an ordinance drafted to prevent the sale of Intoxicating Liquors in the Incorporated Village of Alliance

On Motion Resolved that the Ordinance to prevent the sale of Spirituous or Intoxicating Liquors passed Apr 11<sup>th</sup> 1856 by the town Council of the Incorporated Village of Salem is hereby reported as an ordinance for the adoption of the Town Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance, when it was ordered to its first reading

On Motion Resolved that there be a Committee of two appointed to draft an Ordinance to establish the fees of the Town Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance and report at the next meeting

A Bill was presented by the Board of health demanding ten dollars for their services for the past year which on Motion was laid on the table

On Motion adjourned to meet in one week

The Town Council of the incorporated Village of Alliance met pursuant to adjournment

The Mayor being absent A. C. Stanger was called to the Chair

The Recorder being absent G. W. Keen was appointed Recorder pro. Tem.

S. Cly offered a resolution to appropriate ten dollars to fee a good Lawyer to draft an ordinance restraining the liquor traffic for the incorporated Village of Alliance such as he is willing to defend as strictly in accordance

with the laws of the State

The Mayor came in and took the chair  
After considerable debate Mr A C Haager moved  
to lay the resolution on the table: Carried

The ordinance to prevent the sale of spirituous  
or intoxicating liquors was then ordered to its second  
reading

Mr Keen offered the following amendatory section  
to the ordinance -

The term "Intoxicating drinks" in the first section  
of this ordinance shall be held to mean and include  
(in addition to all distilled liquors) Ale, Cider, Lager Beer,  
Dr Clarke's Stomach Bitters, Scheidam Schnapps, Ginger Pop,  
Mineral Water and Sarsaparilla; and to vend, sell, or  
give away, or in any manner dispose of any of these  
drinks shall be deemed a violation of this ordinance.

This led to an animated debate -

Mr Burden offered an amendment to the amendment,  
striking out all of the items named except ale and  
Beer, which was lost -

The amendment was then put and lost -

Mr Cly from the committee appointed for that  
purpose on last meeting, reported an ordinance  
"Establishing the fees of the Council of the Incorporated  
Village of Alliance, which was read the first time

Ordinance regulating the fees

Sec 1. Be it enacted an ordained by the Council of the  
Incorporated Village of Alliance that the Mayor, recorder and  
trustees be each entitled to fifty cents for attendance at each  
regular or special meeting doing business, and that the Recorder  
be entitled to ten cents for every hundred words by him  
recorded

Sec 2. It shall be the duty of the recorder to keep  
a roll of the Members of the Council of the Incorporated Village  
of Alliance, which Roll shall be called at every meeting  
doing business within the incorporation -

Sec 3. It shall be the duty of the Recorder to report at  
the last meeting in March the number of meetings that  
each Member has attended during the year

its passage and publication
