An Ordinance to
prevent the Peddling of
Pies and cakes, at the
Crossings in Alliance

Sec^{ty} 1st

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the
Incorporated Village of Alliance, That it shall
be unlawful for any person or persons to peddle
Apples, Pies or cakes at or near the Crossings of the
Cleveland and Pittsburgh and Pittsburg
Fort Wayne and Chicago Railroads, in said
Incorporated Village.

Sec^{ty} 2nd

That if any person or persons shall be
guilty of so peddling Apples, Pies or cakes at
or near the Rail Road Crossings in said
Incorporated Village of Alliance, in Violation
of any of the Provisions of the foregoing
Section of this Ordinance, Said person or
persons so offending shall on conviction
thereof, be punished by a fine not exceeding

Five Dollars, nor less than one Dollar, and Cost
of Prosecution; and on default of payment of fine
and costs, shall be imprisoned in the Jail of
Stark County, not to exceed ten days, at the
discretion of the Mayor.

Sec^o 3^o

That the Marshal shall be and is
hereby authorized and required to arrest
On View, information, or Warrant, and take
before the Mayor, any person or persons
who shall be guilty of violating any of
the Provisions of this Ordinance, or any
Other Ordinance in force within this Incorporation
and there be dealt with according to Law,

Sec^o 4th

That this Ordinance take effect and
be in force from and after its passage
and Publication
