Motion to swine  
running at large

on motion the ordinance in relation to swine  
running at large was adopted

in ordinance

Sec 1

An ordinance to prevent swine sunning at large  
Be it ordained by the Town Council of the incorpo-  
rated village of Alliance

That it shall be unlawful for any swine to run  
at large in the limits of the said incorporated  
village of Alliance (said swine being of the age  
of sixty days

Sec 2

It shall be lawful and is hereby made the duty  
of the Marshall of said Incorporated village  
to take into his custody all swine found run-  
ning at large contrary to this ordinance and  
to dispose of them as herein after provided

Sec 3

The Marshall <sup>shall</sup> immediately advertise and sell  
all swine taken up by him under the provision  
of this ordinance by giving at least ten days  
notice of the time and place of said sale  
by posting up notices in five of the most public  
places in said village said notice shall contain  
in addition to the time and place of sale a correct  
& discription of the size color and supposed  
age of the swine to be sold a copy of said  
notice be deposited with the recorder of said  
village who shall file the same in his office

The Marshall shall after deducting the fees allowed him under this ordinance pay the ballance (if any hereafter) to the owner or owners of said swine and if the owner thereof be unknown to the Marshall he shall pay the ballance into the treasury of said village

Sec 5

The Marshall of said village shall be entitled for every hog taken up under the provisions of this ordinance the sum of Twenty five Cents for taking up. Provide that if more than one hog be taken up at the same time belong to the same owner he shall not be entitled to any additional fee therefore said Marshall shall also be entitled to the sum of ten Cents a day for keeping each hog during the time the same may remain in custody also the sum of fifty Cents for selling also the recorder the sum of five Cents for filing copy of notice

Sec 6

It shall be the duty of the Marshall to take all ordinary care of all swine taken into his custody under the provision of this ordinance and not suffer the same to be lessened in value for want of feed or by being kept in an improper place The Marshall so offending upon conviction thereof before the Mayor on complaint by the owner or his agent be fined in any sum not less than one dollar nor more than five dollars the same to go for the use of the Corporation and be answerable to the owner for all damages

Sec 7

The owner of any swine taken into the custody by the Marshall under the provisions of this ordinance shall be entitled to the possession on proof of ownership and pay cost and charges of Marshall as fixed by this ordinance to the time of claiming the same

Sec 8

This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage and publication

Sec 1

Be it ordained by the council of the incorporated village of Alliance } Person or

That it shall be unlawful for any persons to sell by way of public auction outcry or vendue either directly or indirectly within the incorporated limits of said village of Alliance any property or effects whatsoever Except utensils of Husbandry Household Furniture real estate produce, Horses, mules sheep Hogs or meat cattle or any officer of the state county Township or village selling any property or effects directed by law to be sold, or permanent residents of said village; without first obtaining a license therefor from the Mayor or in his absence the recorder

Sec 2

That said Mayor or in his absence the recorder shall on application issue a license to any person or persons to sell any goods or merchandise that are not residents herein before excepted and charge therefore a sum not less than fifty cents nor more than five dollars for each day or part of a day

Sec 3

That if any person shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance by selling any article not herein excepted at public auction vendue or outcry shall forfeit and pay a sum not less than two dollars nor more than ten dollars for every each such offence

Sec 4

That the collection of the aforesaid fine shall not releas any person or persons from the payment of the regular fee for license

Sec 5

That for all violations of this ordinance That the person Mayor or other officers having or taking jurisdiction of the same shall issue his warrants for the arrest of any person or persons for such violation of this ordinance & upon affidavits being filed in his office setting forth the nature of the violation complained of and upon consideration thereof said officer shall fix the amount of the said fine and render judgment thereon in the name of the Incorporated Village of Alliance and issue execution thereon

On Motion  
Sidewalk ordinance

on motion the sidewalk ordinance was adopted  
Be it ordained by the Town Council of the incorporated  
village of Alliance

Sec 1

That all persons owning lots or parts of lots in  
any public street in said incorporated village  
shall, and they are hereby respectively required  
within thirty days after receiving notice from  
the recorder of said village, to plank or  
pare the side walks fronting such lots or  
lots as such order may direct of such width and  
grade as may be established by said council

Sec 2

It shall be the duty of the Recorder upon order  
of the council to give notice as such as the  
Council may prescribe either by writing or  
publication to the owners of all lots or parts  
of lots on such street or streets as may be  
designated by said order

Sec 3

That if any person fails to comply with the  
provisions of the first section of the ordinance  
in accordance with said notice, that it  
shall be the duty of such persons as may  
hereafter be appointed by the council to cause  
the same to be done as above provided and  
charge the same to ~~such~~ as above persons  
as may own said lots or parts of lots and  
to be by him collected in civil action before  
any officer having jurisdiction of the same

This ordinance shall be in force from and
