Council Elect Met. by call of Mayor.  
 Linus Ely Mayor Present. D. Hoover Recorder  
 Sworn, and C. B. Pierce, Henry Altman, and  
 M. R. Shalters sworn as Council. Wm. H. Seal  
 Treasurer Elect. have Bond in the sum of Five  
 hundred dollars. (which was approved by Council,) and  
 duly sworn On Motion of M. R. Shalters the  
 Marshalls Bond was fixed at Three hundred dollars  
 and the Trustees of Highways were required to  
 give Bonds of two hundred dollars each.  
 On Motion Council adjourn to meet next Mo-  
 nesday evening April 11. at 7 o'clock.

Alliance April 11. 1860

The Town Council of the incorporated Village of Alliance  
 Met pursuant to adjournment. Minutes of last meeting  
 read and approved.

Present Linus Ely Mayor. Council Elect all  
 present. Simon Johnson Jr. Mayor Elect. was  
 sworn. and took his seat. And Linus Ely and  
 Daniel Joseph were sworn as Council.  
 The Mayor. Marshall. and Street-Commissioner  
 gave Bonds to the satisfaction of the Council.  
 The Street Commissioners cast lots. which resulted  
 Electing Eli Grant for 1 year. Isaac Seters for 2 years  
 and Isaac Heartzell for 3 years.

On Motion of Linus Ely. Henry Altman and  
 M. R. Shalters were appointed a Committee. to see to  
 letting or laying the ballance of Sidewalk not laid  
 was required by Notice to be laid October 1859.

On Motion of Linus Ely. an ordinance to establish  
 a hook Ladder & Bucket. Companies. Was brought  
 up and passed its first-reading.

On Motion of M. R. Shalters the regular night-  
 meeting of Council shall be the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday  
 evenings of each month.
