Council Met by a call of the mayor.

Mayor Johnson in the chair. Council Present

Linus Ely Moved that the Recorder be instructed  
to notify the County Auditor to assess three  
hundred dollars for the Incorporated Village of  
Alliance for Corporation purposes.

On motion of L. Ely the Committee on Side W  
was instructed to procure a correct list immediate  
of Lots not paved or planked according to previous  
Notice, and to be placed in the hands of the Recorder  
and by him forwarded to the County Auditor  
to be assessed on the respective Lots as per estimate  
for planking or paving the same.

On motion Council adjourn.

Alliance June 4, 1860.

Council met pursuant to adjournment.

Minutes of last meeting called for read and  
approved.

Present, Mayor Johnson in the Chair

Council all present.

Hook Ladder & Bucket  
Companies

On motion An ordinance to establish a Hook,  
Ladder, and Bucket Companies was taken up and  
passed its third reading, which is as follows.

Sec 1.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the incorporated  
Village of Alliance, That any number of able bodied  
citizens of said Village, over the age of 18 years, and under 45  
years of age may form themselves into a Hook Ladder & Bucket  
Company, for the purpose of extinguishing fire, Not ex-  
ceeding 20 in number nor less than 15.

Sec 2.

That as soon as any Company, shall be formed under  
the provisions of this ordinance, and be accepted  
by the Council, they shall proceed to elect the  
following officers, out of their number who shall

Serve for the Period of one year. To wit, one <sup>fire</sup> foreman or Captain, One assistant, One Secretary, and one Treasurer, Who shall perform all the duties of like officers of fire Companies.

Sec 3<sup>rd</sup> Said Companies shall have power to make all need-ful rules and regulations for the Government of their said Companies, Subject to the approval of the Town Council of said Village,

Sec 4<sup>th</sup> The Mayor shall issue his Commission to each of said officers, <sup>semi</sup>annually after their election upon the Certificate of the Secretary of said Company.

Sec 5<sup>th</sup> The Council shall on making an appropriation to furnish any Company on its organization, not less than fifty Buckets, Six Hooks of different sizes, Three <sup>40 30 20</sup> ladders of different lengths, Sufficient Ropes, and not less than two axes, and provide a suitable place to keep the same <sup>56 2 Ladder truck</sup>

Sec 6<sup>th</sup> That any person or persons taking and carrying away from the place where the property of said Company is kept or from any fire or using or appropriating any of the Buckets Ladders Hooks or axes shall be fined in any sum not exceeding five dollars nor less than one dollar, to be recovered before the Mayor, in the name of said Company.

Sec 7<sup>th</sup> The Mayor shall pay all fines recovered under this ordinance into the treasurer of the proper Company within twenty days after he shall receive the same for the use of said Company.

Sec 8<sup>th</sup> This ordinance to take effect and be in force on and after its passage and Publication. Passed June 8, 1860
