Council Met by Call of the Mayor. -
 Mayor Johnson Presiding. Council present -
 Ely, Shalters, Joseph, and Hoover. On Motion
 of Ely Resolved, that any person feeling themselves
 injured by the vacating of alleys in Alliance as
 described in Petition of Charles M. Hester, and
 Rebecca W. Hester filed in Court of Common Pleas
 of Stark County Ohio July 20. 1860. also the Petition
 of C. M. Hester and others to vacate alleys in Alliance
 Filed in Court of Common Pleas of Stark County Ohio
 August 3. 1860. And wish to defend the same
 the Incorporation agree to pay all costs of Court
 (If adjudged against them) Provided they will
 prosecute through the Solicitor of the Incorporation
 On motion of Shalters & P. D. Ramsey have the
 Job of building a Lock up as prescribed in Schedule
 of C. Hoover, provided the Committee can get
 a lease of suitable ground to build it on for
 three years. The price for putting it up to be one
 hundred and forty dollars.
 On motion the Council adjourn
 C. Hoover. Recorder.
