Council met pursuant to adjournment.

On motion of Ely there be a Committee of two in concert with the Solicitor, to revise all Laws punishable by imprisonment in the County Jail, or by fines, so as to apply, or be made punishable in the Lockup of the Incorporated Village Alliance Stark County Ohio.

On motion of Ely, M. R. Shalters & C. B. Pierce was appointed said Committee.

on motion, The Com. on Symmetry grounds was given one month more to make their report, and on motion M. R. Shalters was appointed on said Com. in place of Finus Ely, resigned.

on motion the Committee on building Lockup was instructed to examine the same, and if built according to contract, to instruct the Recorder to issue orders on the Treasurer for the cost of Contract.
