

Alliance March 4, 1861

Council met pursuant to adjournment.

The Mayor being absent the Recorder presided.  
Council Present: Messrs. Altman, Pierce, Joseph & Hoover. Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

Side walks.

On motion of Pierce the petition laid on the table at our last meeting. Signed by C. G. Packard and 13 others was taken up and passed.

On motion of Pierce there be a Committee of 3 appointed by the Chair to let the Job of Street and alley Crossings on South Side main Street and from Baptist Church to main Street. with 1 Timber Crossing 1 foot ~~face~~. (Carried)The ~~Mayor~~ <sup>Chair</sup> appointed N. Joseph & M. R. Shalters said Committee.  
On motion of Pierce the Recorder was instructed to notify owners of Lots on South Side main Street to pave their lots according to grade established and side walk ordinance said walk to be 4 ft wide Planked or paved.

Orders Issued

On motion of Altman the Recorder was instructed to issue orders on the Treasury in favor of A. Emerson for 3.50 dollars ~~pay~~ half of laying side walk as taxed up against said Emerson. And 1.00 dollar to David Moore for Bolts and clasps on Lock up. and 25 dollars in favor of John A. Kingsberry one half the assessment taxed up against C. & S. R. R. Co. for plank walk.
