Monday evening Feby 19. 1877

Council convened in regular session, Mayor Barnaby presiding.

Members present: Leek, Vincent, Gray, Johns and Strong. Absent H. C. Ellison.

Vincent moved that the part in the plans and Specifications for grading & paving the gutter of Alliance Street, relating to tile drain be stricken out, seconded by Gray and carried.

A. W. Coates was permitted to make some remarks in regard to grade on Alliance Street in front of his new building, when on motion of Vincent seconded by Gray the matter was referred to Grade Committee for investigation and Report.

Vincent moved that the Street Committee be instructed to purchase a new Scrapper at a cost not to exceed \$45⁰⁰, seconded by Strong and carried.

Gray moved that the Committee on Safe be requested to report at next regular meeting, seconded by Leek and carried.

No further business to be attended to, on motion Council adjourned.

Monday evening March 5. 1877

Council convened in regular session Mayor Barnaby presiding. Present: Leek, Vincent, Gray & Strong. Absent: Ellison and Johns.

Minutes of the two last regular meetings read and approved.

Gas Committee reported that a fetterhead had been with M. M. King Esq for use of

lower Room, Gas & Fuel, by which he agreed to pay at the Rate of Five ⁰⁰ Dollars per month for use of Room, Gas & Fuel.

On motion of Gray seconded by Vincent Report was accepted.

Sidewalk Committee per Gray reported that they had purchased a new Scrape for ~~to be~~ delivered at Alliance on board of Cars.

On motion of Strong seconded by Leek report was accepted.

Safe Committee per Strong reported that they thought it necessary & expedient to purchase a safe for the keeping of the town Records.

On motion of Vincent seconded by Leek the Committee were instructed to purchase a safe.

Vincent moved that the matter of elevations for sidewalks be referred to City Solicitor & Civil Engineer seconded by Gray & Carried.

Strong moved that a new sidewalk be ordered on Third Street in Hester, Addition ~~on~~ the west side between Avenue 2^d North Depot Street, then on the east side between North Depot Street along the C & P. R. R. lands ~~to~~ Farwells Machine Shop seconded by Leek & Carried.

Report of Mayor Barnaby of Fines & Licenses & amounting to \$732⁰⁰ was read, accepted & filed on motion of Gray seconded by Strong.
