An Ordinance to punish Drunkenness 109

By it ordained by the town council of the incorporate village of Alliance that it shall be unlawful for any person to be in a state of intoxication or drunk within the limits of the incorporate village of Alliance every person so offending shall upon conviction thereof before the Mayor of said Village be fined in any sum not less than one dollar nor more than ten dollars and cost of prosecution or be imprisoned in the village prison not less than three nor more than ten days or both at the discretion of the Mayor

Sec 2a

All prosecutions under this ordinance shall be in name of the Incorporate Village of Alliance and upon affidavit in writing setting forth the charge clearly

Sec 3a

The Mayor shall at his discretion require security for cost from the prosecuting witness in all prosecutions under this ordinance before commencing the same unless the charge or affidavit be filed by the Marshall of said Village.

The security shall be liable for all cost if the action is not sustained and no cost can be collected off of the defendant the village shall pay the cost & also

all cases prosecuted by the Marshall where the cost cannot be collected of the defendant

Sec 4

All fines and penalties collected by the Mayor under this ordinance shall be paid by him into the village treasury within ten days after the collection thereof

Sec 5th speaking clause

An ordinance passed May 30th 1855 entitled an ordinance to prevent Drunkenness be and the same is hereby repealed this ordinance to be in force from and after its passage & publication
