Council met according to previous adjournment Mayor Buck presiding

Council present were G Milner W L Coffee H Aultman & Joseph

Minutes of last meeting read and approved The recorder was instructed to notify the county auditor to assess a tax of one hundred dollars for the incorporate village of Alliance for corporations purpose

Council met at the regular meeting Mayor Buck presiding Council present were H Aultman W L Coffee John Staub & Joseph & G Milner Minutes of last meeting read and approved

of W L Coffee H Aultman & John Staub were appointed a committee on streets sidewalks & alley

The ordinance on keeping the village prison paper its second reading

of H Aultman the Marshall ~~was~~ allowed the sum of fifty cents per day for maintaining prisoners in the village prison of the incorporate village of Alliance

of H Aultman the third reading of the ordinance on keeping the village prison was dispensed to pass the ordinance this evening

Sec 1st Be it ordained by the town council of the incorporate village of Alliance that the village prison shall be under the care and control of the village Marshall who shall receive into his custody in said prison all persons sentenced to confinement in for violation of any of the ordinance

An ordinance regulating the keeping of the village prison

Sec 2a

of said village and detain all such persons until they are discharged by due course of law
The Marshall shall be entitled to receive the sum of fifty cents per day for maintaining all persons in said prison and shall return the whole cost in every case of maintaining prisoners upon the mittimus to the Mayor or other officer after the expiration of sentence

Sec 3a

The Marshall may use said prison for detaining prisoners before trial or during continuance of a cause but shall return the cost of keeping separate from that accruing after sentence

Sec 4th

It shall be unlawful for the Marshall to use any unnecessary violence upon the person of any prisoner or to neglect to furnish him or her the proper amount of food or fuel to make him or her comfortable during the time they may remain in his custody therein the Marshall so offending shall upon conviction thereof before the Mayor be fined in any sum not exceeding two dollars

Sec 5th

all prosecutions under this ordinance shall be in the name of the incorporate village of Albion and upon affidavit in writing and all fines collected for the violations of this ordinance shall be immediately paid into the village treasury

Sec 6th

This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage and publication of H. Aultman the above ordinance was passed when the yeas & nays stood as follows
