amendment to Hog Law

May 27th 1963 Council met Mayor Barnaby presiding
Be it ordained by the Town Council of the incorporated Village
of Alliance — The Marshall immediately advertise & sell
all swine taken up by him under the provisions of
this ordinance by giving at least three days notice
of the time & place of sale by posting up notices in
~~three~~ different places (most public) in said village — Said notices
shall contain in addition to the time & place of sale
a correct description of the size & color & supposed age
of the swine to be sold, a copy of said notice
to be deposited with the recorder of said village
who shall file the same in his office

Adopted on
third reading

& The marshal of said village shall be entitled
for every hog taken up under the provision of this ordinance
the sum of twenty five cents for taking up
of the same belonging to the same owner. He shall
not be entitled to any additional fee — therefore
said Marshal shall also be entitled to the sum
of twenty five cents a day for keeping each hog
during the time the same may remain
in custody Also the sum of fifty cents for selling
Also the ^{Recorder the} sum of five cents for filing a copy
of the notice

Section 3 & 5th of an ordinance in relation to hogs running
at large passed Aug 1st 1959

On motion the above ordinance was adopted
passed upon the third reading
