Ordinance on
Fire Crackers

Be it ordained by the Town Council
of the incorporated Village of Alliance that it shall
be unlawful for any person to sell or
give away any fire Crackers to be discharged
in any of the streets or public grounds
or alleys within the incorporated ^{limits} ~~village~~
of said Village - Any person so offending
shall upon conviction thereof before the Mayor
or other proper Officer, forfeit and
pay a fine not exceeding ten dollars
nor less than one dollar with costs of prosecution

Sec 1st

It shall be unlawful for any person
to discharge fire Crackers within the public streets
alleys or public grounds of said incorporated
village - Every person so offending shall forfeit
upon conviction thereof a fine of
not more than five dollars nor less than one dollar
or be imprisoned in the village prison
not more than ten hours nor less than one hour
at the discretion of the Court

Sec 1st Be it ordained by the Town Council of

the incorporated Village of Alliance that Privilege is hereby

granted to the Pittsburg St Wayne & Chicago Rail Way Co to lay

down pipes along certain Streets & Alleys as best suited

their convenience for the conveyance of water from the

reservoir to their Shops & other buildings at or near

around the depot

under ground & in such a manner as

not to interfere with the proper drain

age or use of said Streets or Alleys

An ordinance to provide
for the organization of
a Gas Co in

Sec 1st be it ordained by the Town Council of the incorporated Village of Alliance Stark Co Ohio that Alfred H. Knowlton & Co of the City of Logansport Indiana their Associates Successors Heirs & Assigns acting under the name of the Alliance Gas Light Co be & they are hereby vested with the exclusive privilege for the term of Seventy five years from the passage of this ordinance of using the Streets & Alleys of said village as it is now laid out or may hereafter be laid out and enlarged for the purpose of laying down in said Streets & Alleys pipes for the conveyance of Gas in & through said Streets & Alleys for the use of said Village & inhabitants provided that said pipes do not interfere with the drainage of said Streets or construction of underground sewers or underground fixtures for drainage or with the use of said Streets for the purpose of Common Travel.

Section 2nd

That in consideration of a Compliance with this ordinance the property & fixtures necessary to operate the gas works of said Company shall be & are hereby Exempted from the payment of Village Tax for the term period of four years from the 1st day of January 1865

Sec 3

That whenever the Company propose to open any Street or Alley for the purpose of laying down Gas pipe on the same they shall give the Village board of St Commissioners three days notice thereof & shall at no time during the progress of their work obstruct the passage of the whole of said Street or Alley at one time & shall at no time suspend work & leave obstructions in the Streets or Alleys & further they shall within a reasonable time put the said Streets or Alleys in as good condition as it was before being so broken.

Sec 4th

The Company shall furnish gas to the Citizens at a price not to exceed four dollars per thousand cubic feet. And in consideration of the privileges herein granted they shall furnish to said Village such quantities of gas as they may desire for the use of the Village at a price not to exceed three dollars per thousand cubic feet provided said Village furnish at their own Expense the Lamp posts, lanterns & fixtures.

Sec 5th

That if the Council of said Village shall at any time desire to erect lamps at the Engine House, public school house or other public buildings or to light any Street or Alley off from the main Street the gas Company shall for a fair compensation paid by said Village lay down in a reasonable time the necessary pipes & fixtures ordered by said Village and the lamps thus erected shall be supplied by said Company aforesaid with gas upon the same terms prescribed in the preceding sections & the pipe thus laid down at the Expense of the Village shall not directly or ~~immediately~~ indirectly be used for furnishing gas to individual Citizens without the consent of said Village nor shall said Company lay off gas pipes within the portions of streets or alleys occupied by pipes of the Village unless the
