

Alliance, O. May 2^d 1866

Council met pursuant to adjournment Mayor Buck presiding -

Councilmen present P. H. Barr, Thos. Buckman, + Henry Altman. - Minutes of previous meeting read. -

Bill of J. B. Johnson, St. Comr. was presented for services as St. Comr. for past year, and on motion of Buckman, Mayor Buck, Altman, Barr + Buckman, were appointed to examine said bill and also examine in to the duty, authority &c of Street Commissioners -

A Petition was presented signed by James McMichael, Salathiel Whitacre + 17 others. Citizens of Alliance, praying that the Council take in to consideration, a Culvert under the C. + P. R. R. by which all the water that collects from the Hillside in south Alliance, into the Rail Road ditch, with its accumulation of filth is poured out upon what is familiarly known as Buck street, greatly to the damage of said street, and to personal property. -

On motion of Buckman, the Petition was received and filed, and Mayor Buck + Altman appointed as a committee to investigate + report on said petition. -

On motion of Barr, W. H. Drepler, Esq. was appointed Solicitor, of the incorporated Village of Alliance.

On motion of Barr, Henry Altman was appointed + authorized to borrow a sufficient amt. of money for the borough of Alliance, to pay the claim of Mr. Burnet, due Apr. 29th 66. -

A Petition was presented, signed by Seters, Lamborn, + Co. and 3 others, Citizens of Alliance, asking that Broadway St. be opened from Liberty street to any point eleven chains east of the C. + P. R. R. and also asking the vacation of the road now running east from said C. + P. R. R. -

In view of said Petition the following resolution was passed by the council -

Resolved, that the Town Council of the incorporated Village of Alliance, hereby locate + extend Broadway street from Liberty street (east) under the name of Broadway street, until it intersects the County line Road, said street to be 65 feet, and it is hereby
