The Council Met at the Call of the Mayor, who was in the Chair, Members present Buckman, Garrison Stanley, Amerman and Barnaby,

the Minutes of two last Meetings read and approved, on Motion of Garrison, Jas Amerman, was appointed solicitor for the Village to serve until the next Election of Village Officers,

On Motion J. G. Stanley, was authorized to contract to have abutments erected for side walk at Bridge on West Avenue St.
