

Alliance February 3rd 1868

Council met pursuant to adjournment. Mayor Buck in the Chair. Members present Arnuman, O.W. Buckman, Stanley and Barnaby. On and Speaker presented a Bill for a stone & pipe for Lockup and 800 lbs of coal furnished for same. Amount in all \$13.90 which on Motion was accepted and an order drawn on the Treasurer for the amount.

The following Resolutions was presented and passed by a unanimous Vote.

Resolved, as the sense of the town Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance, that the said Council will sell in fee simple to any person or incorporation the Lots belonging to said Town fronting on Market and Freedom street, at the cost price including the interest from the time of the purchase by the town of said Lots, upon condition that said property shall be improved the present year (1868) by the erection thereon at a cost of not less than \$30000⁰⁰ dollars including the price of the said lots or the said Council will take stock in any incorporated Company for the improvement of said lots to the amount of \$5000⁰⁰ dollars, provided the House or building on said lots is thereby secured
