

Alliance June 27<sup>th</sup> 1868.

Having been duly notified, that Linus Ely, Thomas, Buckman, N. G. Thomas and D. G. Hester, Members of the board of Directors for Alliance Union School, had resigned and on this 27<sup>th</sup> day of June 1868, Appointed, H. Laughlin, W. Greiner, Bradford Miller and P. H. Barr, to fill the vacancies, occasioned by the resignation of the above named Ely, Buckman, Thomas, and Hester.

Council Met pursuant to adjournment Mayor Ewan in the Chair, Members present, J. N. Blackburn, P. P. Johnson, J. W. Lyder, L. B. Davis and J. Barnaby.

Minutes of Meetings held in last month read and approved. The Committee appointed to confer with the township Trustees in relation to sinking a Public Well, Reported that they had performed the duties enjoined upon them, and that said Trustees favored the project of sinking said well, and proposed to meet a Committee appointed by the Council for conference in relation to the matter at any time the said Council may designate. Report accepted and Committee discharged.

The Committee appointed to negotiate with W. Hester for the purchase a strip of land lying on the west side of Park Street for the purpose of increasing the width of said street to 50 feet, Reported that they had constructed said land for the sum of \$250.00 payable on the first of next with interest, Report accepted and Committee discharged.

The Committee appointed to borrow money and pay interest due on bonds held by A. Summers & Mrs. Johnson, reported that they had borrowed \$800.00 of J. W. Barnaby for three months at the rate of 10 percent interest, and issued an order of the treasury for the same, and paid bond holders. Report accepted and Committee discharged.

The Committee appointed to employ a surveyor, for the purpose of making a survey and plat, of the territory proposed to be annexed to the Corporation, Reported that they had employed E. W. Johnson, to make said survey and that the same had been done accordingly, and said Johnson is now ready to make a plat of said territory, Reported accepted and Committee discharged.

Resolved that the Territory proposed to be annexed to the Corporation be extended so as to include the farms of Wm. D.
