expense of moving & putting down the same, and also
agreeing to replace said walk on his own premises by
putting thereon a Brick walk, Petition received and the
prayer of the Petitioner Granted

On Motion A side walk was ordered on the north side of Columbia
street from Arch to Depot streets, of the usual width and
material and to be Completed by the 23rd day of the present
month,

On Motion The Recorder was instructed to put a notice in the Monitor
requiring all persons to Repair their side walks and put them
in good order within ten days from the date of said notice,

On Motion The Mayor and Recorder were instructed to execute and deliver
to J. B. Miller for \$252.⁰⁰ dollars to lift a Bond held by Jesse
Miller, against the Village.

The Committee continued at last meeting on the matter of the water-piping down North Liberty street. Report that a living Brook attorney for the Rail way Co. has informed them that said Rail way Co. declines to do anything in the matter, Report accepted and Council discharged;

Wm Jones and J. M. Lyair were appointed as a Committee to adopt some plan to extinguish, and to ascertain the cost of apparatus and fixtures for a Hook & Ladder & Bucket Co.
