George Stroup for P. B. Garland presented a Bill for side walks and  
 Street Croppings which on Motion was accepted and an order  
 drawn on the Treasurer for the amount \$634.14.  
 A Petition <sup>signed by Amos Ailes, Inebah Rowley, Wm Eldred & Elias Elliott</sup> was presented, asking that a side walk be ordered  
 down on the west side of 5<sup>th</sup> street, commencing at Market street  
 and running thence south to Broad street, said walk to be six  
 feet in width and of the usual material. On Motion the  
 petition received and the prayer of the petitioners granted,  
 the following bills were presented and accepted and orders drawn  
 on the Treasurer for their respective amounts

 against the Village were satisfactory, to the Council.

An Ordinance was presented fixing the salary of Mayor  
 and Marshal of the Village as follows:

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Incor-  
 porated Village of Alliance,

sec 1<sup>st</sup> That the Mayor of said Village shall receive as his salary  
 the sum of One Hundred dollars per year, payable  
 quarterly out of the Treasury of the Incorporation, on the  
 warrant of the Mayor & Recorder,

sec 2<sup>d</sup> That the Marshal of the said Village, shall receive as his  
 salary the sum of Two Hundred dollars per year pay-  
 able quarterly out of the Treasury of the Incorporation on  
 the warrant of the Mayor & Recorder,

sec 3<sup>d</sup> This Ordinance shall be in force from and after its  
 passage.
