

Alliance April 8<sup>th</sup> 1870

At the Annual Election held on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April 1870, for the election of Officers for the Incorporated Village of Alliance, the following persons were duly Elected and certified ~~by~~ to Me by the Judges of said Election N. Laughlin, for Mayor for the term of two years John C. Morgan, A. H. Coates & Leinus Ely Councilmen for the term of two years, and Henry Altman, Sam<sup>l</sup>. Clapsaddle & Mrs Jones, Councilmen for one year, W. H. Seal, Treasurer, for two years, J. G. Hogue, Marshal, two years, and Joseph Barnaby Recorder, for two years.

Joseph Barnaby, Recorder.

A Regular Meeting of the Town Council was holden April 11<sup>th</sup> 1870, J. D. Parker Mayor in the Chair the Officers Elect all appeared as follows, N. Laughlin Mayor, J. C. Morgan, A. H. Coates, Leinus Ely, Henry Altman Samuel Clapsaddle and Mrs Jones, Councilmen, W. H. Seal, Treasurer, Joseph Barnaby, Recorder, and J. G. Hogue, Marshal, who were by J. D. Parker, severally sworn and affirmed as required by law.

N. Laughlin, Presented his Bond in the sum of \$1000. <sup>(as sureties)</sup> signed by J. B. Lutz, G. Saurbeck & J. D. Parker, which on Motion was approved.

W. H. Seal, presented his Bond as Treasurer, in the sum of \$10,000.00 signed by W. G. Coffey & P. F. Rosenberg as sureties, which on Motion was accepted and approved.

On Motion of L. Ely, an order was drawn on the Treasurer in favor of W. H. Seal, for \$50.00 to apply on fees as paid.

On Motion Adjourned to Meet on Monday Evening the 18<sup>th</sup> at 7 o'clock.

Council Met pursuant to adjournment Mayor N. Laughlin, in the Chair, present A. H. Coates, L. Ely, J. C. Morgan, H. Altman, Sam<sup>l</sup>. Clapsaddle & Mrs Jones, Minutes of last Meeting read and approved. The Committee to whom was refered the Matter of a division of the roads between the Township & Village with referance to working the same, report, that it was agreed between said Committee and the trustees of the Township that the Village work the road <sup>on the</sup> west line of the Village as follows: Commencing at the Junction of Alliance Street with

Road thence north to Elisha Sectors, thence east to the east line of the cemetery, to work the township line road on the east from S. Oysters to Jenkins south line, and Liberty street from the south line of the incorporation south to the Mt. Union & Salem Roads Report received and on Motion laid over for further consideration.

Dr R. P. Johnson and Dr G. H. Smith, <sup>for 1 year</sup> which on Motion were appointed by the following vote, Yeas,  
A. Altman, J. Clapsaddle, A. W. Coates, L. Ely, W. Jones and J. C. Morgan, 6 nays none.

Street Comptroller

The name of J. B. Johnson, as street Commissioner was presented by the Mayor, thereupon on Motion of A. Altman, he was elected by the following vote Yeas J. C. Morgan, Ely, Coates Jones, Clapsaddle and Altman 6 nays none.

Solicitor

The name of J. D. Parker as solicitor for the Village having been presented by the Mayor, on Motion of A. W. Coates he was elected by the following vote Yeas, J. C. Morgan, Ely, Coates, Jones, Clapsaddle & Altman 6 nays none.

Bills

Patterson & McKee presented a Bill for Printing Election tickets, Proclamations &c which on Motion was referred to the finance,  
Enos Hoopes present a Bill for Gravel for streets which on Motion referred to Financial Committee  
J. G. Hogue presented a Bill for services as Marshal referred to Committee on Finance,

On Motion of L. Ely, Resolved that the Judgment of J. Stockert & wife against the Village be prosecuted no farther but paid off as soon as the means can be obtained, The above resolution passed by a vote of five to one A. W. Coates voting in the negative.

The following resolution was offered by A. W. Coates, Be it Resolved by the City Council of Alliance, that the Citizens or a part thereof on Mt Union street be authorized to procure the County surveyor to establish the center line of Mt Union street within the Corporation limits
