Council Met pursuant to adjournment. Mayor Laughlin in the Chair, Present H. Altman, Clapsaddle, A. W. Coates, Wm. Jones & J. C. Morgan. Minutes of last meeting read and approved. The solicitor reported that he had examined the matter of opening Mt. Union street to the width of sixty feet, and that the Village have the right to require said street to that width.

Petition was presented signed by Jos. Powell D. Pembroke and others asking that a side walk be put down on the west side of Station street from Dant. Miller's corner to Broad street, which on Motion was referred to Committee on side walks.

The committee on streets & alleys ~~suggested~~ that in their opinion it would be proper to appoint a person other than the street Commissioners, to collect the money of those persons who prefer paying ^{three dollars} ~~the money~~ in lieu of working two days on the streets as required by law.

On Motion

of A.M. Coates following resolution was offered, Resolved that the persons owning property on Mt. Union street from Alliance street south to the south line of the incorporation be required and notified to move their fences on each side of said street so that there shall be thirty feet between their said fences and the center of the ^{said} street, and also to move their side walks back to the fences so required to be moved, the same to be done within sixty days from the date of this order, And that the street Commissioners be required to give notice in writing to the different owners of Lots or Property to comply with this order The above resolution was then taken up and passed as follows Yeas. Altman, Coates, Clapsaddle, Jones & Morgan 5. Nays none,

A resolution was presented by Mrs Jones, as follows Resolved that the hours of Meetings of the Council shall be between the hours of seven and ten o'clock in the evening, and that any business that can not be disposed of within that time shall be laid over until the next meeting, said Resolution was then taken up and passed as follows; Yeas Altman Coates, Clapsaddle, Jones and Morgan, 5. Nays none,

Resolved that there be a side walk put down on the east side of Freedom street from Alliance street thence south to Broadway, that said side walk shall be constructed of Good Pine plank 1 1/2 inches thick laid upon stringers 4x4 inches & four feet apart, said walk shall be six feet in width, the persons owning Lots abutting on said street shall be required to grade the ground under said side walk, before laying the same down Passed as follows, Yeas Altman, Coates, Clapsaddle Jones & Morgan, 5. Nays none, Resolved that Persons owning lot or property abutting on the east side of Mt. Union ^{south of main st} street, and on the south side of Broadway

From Liberty street to the C.P. Rail Road be notified to repair the side walks on said streets at once, Paper as follows, Altruism, Coates, Clapsaddle Jones & Morgan.

Ordinances to provide for the construction & repairing side walks

An Ordinance to provide for the Construction and Repair of sidewalks in the Incorporated Village of Alliance,

sec 1st Be it Ordained and enacted by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance in Stark County, Ohio.

That whenever in the Opinion of the Council it becomes necessary to construct or repair any side walk in said Village, the Council shall pass a resolution declaring that the same shall be constructed or repaired as the case may be, describing said side walk sufficiently to enable the parties interested to determine what side walk is intended to be constructed or repaired, and what kind of Materials are to be used in the construction or repair of the same; and after the passage of any such resolution by the Council, and notice of the same given to the Owner or owners, or agent of the same of the property abutting on the side walk described in said resolution it shall be the duty of the Mayor of said Village on application to him for that purpose to give the owner or owners of property abutting on the side walk, any necessary information in regard to grade or other matters necessary to enable the owner of property to construct or repair said side walk according to the requirements of said resolution.

sec 2 That if any one or more of the owners of property abutting on said side walk shall neglect or refuse to construct or repair his her or their portions of the same within sixty days after receiving notice of the passage of said resolution as required by law, then and in that case the person or persons with whom the said Council may contract there shall (on being directed by resolution of the Council of said town) cause the same to be constructed or repaired upon the most favorable terms. Keeping an accurate account of the cost and expenses of doing the same separate as to the portion of each property abutting on said side walk, and when the same is completed such person or persons as aforesaid shall render an accurate account of the cost and expenses of constructing or repairing the same to the Council of the
