The Committee on Streets and Alleys were authorized to immediately proceed to advertize the letting of a sewer or Rip Rap Drain on the east side of Buck street and to receive Bids for the putting in a 24 inch x 20 inch tile sewer and also for making a Rip Rap Drain, and report at a future Meeting of the Council.

Petition

a Petition was presented signed by the Union School Board, asking side walks be laid on the west side of Depot street, from Grant street, south to the school house in Lambens, additine to the Village, and also a walk from said school House, running west to ~~the~~ Mt.
