Monday evening July 16, 1877

Council convened in regular session
Mayor Day presiding. Roll called: Members
present: Seck, Beardsley, Coates & Vincent.

Absent Gray & J. K. Co.

Minutes of last session read and approved.
G. B. Coates Chairman of Sidewalks stated
that they had examined all bids for putting
down sidewalks carefully and concluded
that it would be the cheapest to employ
some one by the day, the town to furnish
all material and he would move that the
Council accept the bid of Mr P. B. Garland
and employ him at \$1.50 per day to lay
sidewalks & crossings for the current year.
seconded by Mr Seck and carried.

met in Firemans Hall on the evening of June 22
1877 and reorganized ourselves into what has
been known as the fire police. we therefore

On motion of Vincent seconded by Coates
 passed to 2^d reading ordinance to regulate
 use of Animals.

On motion of Vincent seconded by Beardslay
 the Clerk was authorized to draw an order
 for \$300 for use of Board of Health.

On motion of Coates seconded by Beardslay
 new Sidewalks were ordered on west side
 of Park Street along lots of W. J. Pettit Green
 and Mikorts also on North side of Market
 Street in front of lots of Messrs Berckhomer,
 Staples and Ailes. Carried.

On motion of Beardslay seconded by
 Leek a new walk was ordered on West Side
 of Webb Street in front of Smith Lot, J. C.
 Crown Agent.

On motion of Vincent seconded by Leek Council
 adjourned.
