

December 5th 1870

Council Met pursuant to adjournment Mayor Laughlin
in the Chair. Present A. H. Coates, S. Clapsaddle, J. C. Morgan
and Mr. Jones.

Minutes of last Meeting read and after correction approved.
The Committee on the Matter of walling the stream crossing
street south of Burgers & Lowers Mill reported in favor of delay-
ing the work until spring in view of the lateness of the season.
On Motion the report received and approved.

On Motion P. B. Garland was instructed to notify persons residing on
the south side of Alliance street so far as a new side walk
was ordered to be put down ^(on said street) to put the same down.

The Mayor presented his report for the Month of November showing
that he had received and paid over to the Treasurer during
the month \$29.⁰⁰ for Licenses & Tax, On Motion was
received and approved.

On Motion of A. H. Coates, an Order issued by the Mayor & Clerk in
favor of Mrs. Johnson to pay interest due from on Bond
held by him against the Village, on the 1st day of December
was approved and ordered to be inserted in the Minutes
of last Meeting as of that date.

The following Bills were presented and accepted and
orders drawn on the Treasurer for their respective amounts

P. B. Garland for side walks, St Cropping & trunk roads	\$394.70

On Motion Finance Committee were instructed investigate ~~and~~
the financial condition of the Village and report at
the meeting to be held on the 1st Monday evening in
January 1871.

On Motion P. B. Garland was instructed to remove all tree standing on
the side walk near the property of S. Johnson on Mt. Union Street
ordered to be removed at the last Meeting of the Council.

J. B. Milner presented a petition praying for a street crossing on
Mt. Union street opposite the south side of Broad Street, which on Motion
was received and referred to the Committee on Walk & Crossing.

On Motion of A. H. Coates, a street crossing was ordered across Alliance Street
from Dr. M. Caudles corner to E. H. Milner's corner.

The following Resolution was offered and passed.

Resolved that all side walks hereafter put down shall
be laid with Pine Lumber, if made of wood.

On Motion adjourned to meet on 1st Monday evening in Jan'y 1871 at 7 o'clock
