

An Ordinance Vacating ^{sec 1st} Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the
 apart of Park street and incorporated Village of Alliance, that the Portion of said
 part of a ally west thung Park street in Alliance, lying and being between Lots No 13
 + No 14 in Sectors Lamborn & Cos, addition to the town of Alliance,
 being 120 feet long from the north line of Offord street to the
 Alley directly north of Offord street, be and the same is hereby
 declared vacated.

sec 2^d That the Portion of the Alley directly west from that portion
 of Park street vacated in sec 1- being between lots No 14 No 51,
 52 + 53, in Sectors Lamborn & Cos, addition to the Town of
 Alliance, and being 120 feet long from the north line
 of Offord street to the Alley directly north of said Offord
 street be and the same is hereby vacated,

sec 3 This Ordinance shall be in force from its passage and
 Publication as required by law
