Bill S. Brooke

Samuel Brooke presented a Bill for \$39.00 for 250 yds of embankment on West Alliance Street, & running grade to be paid when we get next payment from said street, which was accepted.

Treasurer of Co.

A. H. Coates offered the following resolution, which on motion was laid over until next meeting.

Resolved by the Town Council of Alliance Corporation that the property owners of Business houses on Alliance Street be required to put in hitching Posts in front of said houses planted three feet from the outer edge of the sidewalk with Railing between each post, that said posts and railing be put in within thirty days after the passage of this resolution and notice given thereof, if not done within said time, then the Street Commissioner be authorized to do said work.

Resolution

L. Ely presented a preamble and resolutions as follows:
which on Motion were received and adopted.

Whereas the Citizens of Alliance, have made numerous complaints
about the extravagance of our street Commissioners, therefore
Resolved, that during the year 1871 the street Commissioners
shall collect Poll Tax to pay all his expenses upon streets and
alleys,

Resolved that this Council will pay his bills for work over and
above the amount collected for Poll Tax, except it shall be
done by written order of the Committee on streets & alleys
which order must name the amount to be expended
and the place where expended.

On Motion of St. Altmaw the Contractor for side walks, was forbidden
to remove or take up any walk unless so ordered by
the Committee on side walks, or at the request of the
owner of the lot or lots in front of which it is located
