Monday evening Aug 20. 1877

Council convened in regular session
Mayor Day presiding Roll called
Members present Luke Beardsley
Gray Coates Stokes & Vincent

Minutes of last meeting read & approved.

Sidewalk committee reported favorable
to new walk on West Side of West
Street when on motion of Coates
seconded by Beardsley the walk was
ordered laid from Grant Street to
Alley North of Mrs Joyce.

Petition of Citizens & taxpayers for
a stand for the use of Board & Public
meetings was read & on motion of
Gray seconded by Vincent referred
to Solicitor for information as to the
right of the Council to grant the request.

Special Committee on petition of
Mrs Lydia A Jenkins reported favorable
to the request asked for and Vincent
moved that the Report of the Committee
be adopted & the Petition granted;
seconded by Luke when the matter
upon motion of Coates seconded by
Gray was laid on the table indefinitely
which carried.

On motion of Gray seconded by Coates
passed to 2^d reading the Ordinance
regulating the burying & Cemetery Trustees.

On motion of Gray seconded by Lokes
the clerk was instructed to draw an order
for fifty dollars in favor of Board of Health.
The following was read:

providing for and regulating the Police Dept
of the Incorporated Village of Allamore O. Page
400 I suspended the said M. N. Lowman
from duty on the 15th day of August 1879
Pending your report and investigation,
According to Section 4 of said ordinance.
