Thereupon the following Resolutions were offered by Mr. C. Pennock and duly adopted.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Resolved that a side walk be ordered laid on the south side of Rosenberg street commencing at the east side of Mt. Union street and running thence east to the east side of Arch street, said walk to be of the usual width and material.
- 2<sup>d</sup> Resolved that a side walk be ordered laid on the west side of Webb street, commencing at the north side of Patterson street and running thence north to the north line of Jacob Wrights property on said street, said walk to be of the usual width & material.
- 3<sup>d</sup> Resolved that the side walk on the north side of Alliance street from the west side of Dr. P. H. Barrs property to the west side of Mechanics street be put in good condition placed to the established grade to be 8 feet in width and replaced by a new walk where necessary.
