Called meeting of Council. Members present Mayor W. B. Barber
Councilmen J. W. Bard, J. G. Ernst, W. Madden, & A. Linwood

The proceedings of 2 last meetings read and approved.

Will Conrad presented a bill for lighting Street Lamps
26 nights @ 15¢ (#3.90) Three Dollars and ninety cents.

Chas Johnson Jr presented a bill for rent of pound for year
ending 1st of April 1879. amount Two Dollars (#2.00)

J. G. Ernst moved that the bills be accepted and orders drawn
on the Treasury for payment from the proper funds of the village.
Motion seconded by Mr Linwood vote ayes, Bard - Madden
Linwood & Ernst.

The Marshal presented a bill of \$3.55 for
Fees in a case where the "State of Ohio & Incorporated Village of Mt Union"
was plaintiff vs: Seigler and Anderson of Alliance for Larceny,
in a suit bot by John L Miller. J. G. Ernst moved
to accept and pay the bill from police fund.

Seconded by Mr Madden - Vote Ayes, Madden, Linwood, Bard
and Ernst.

A. Linwood moved that the clerk be instructed
to issue an order on the Cropping Fund to D. Glapthorn of
Stwater, for lumber for St Croppings. when the bill is presented &
certified by the proper committee, see by J. G. Ernst.
Vote Ayes Madden, Linwood, Ernst & Bard.

the death of Oliver Barnaby, it is deemed expedient at this time
to fill the office for the unexpired time, by appointment.

appointed - see by Bard - vote Ernst yes Bard yes.

J. W. Barry be appointed see by Madden, vote
Madden yes, Linwood yes, Bard no, Ernst No.

Madden moved that Wm Neely M. D. be appointed
see by Ernst, vote on motion Ernst yes, Bard yes,
Linwood no Madden yes - lost

Mr Madden moved that Wm Dunn be appointed to fill the
vacancy see by Ernst, vote Ernst yes, Bard no, Linwood
Madden no.
