W. C. Pippett presented a bill for service as solicitor, to mar 17th 1879, amounting to Twenty Dollars (\$20.00).

J. G. Ernst moved to refer the solicitor's bill to the Finance Committee, - seconded by Linwood.
 vote Bard yes, Dilworth yes - Linwood no - Borem yes
 Madden no - Ernst yes. Carried.

E. C. Walton presented a bill for services as st Commissioner and for team work dated Mar 11th & 13th 1878, amounting to \$9.50. Borem moved to accept the bill, sec by Ernst.
 Clerk reports there is money not otherwise appropriated, to the credit of Road Fund to pay the bill.

Ernst moved to amend the motion, and refer the bill to the Committee on Finance, - sec by Madden. vote
 Madden yes, Ernst yes, Borem yes, Linwood yes, Bard yes
 Dilworth yes. The vote on original motion as amended resulted the same, all the members voting in affirmative.
 The Mayor reports there is a vacancy in the Board of Cemetery Trustees on acct of one that was elected last spring failing to qualify. The council directed the Mayor to advertise for the election of a member to fill the vacancy.
