

Council Meeting held as per adjournment  
 April 17th 1879. at Mayor H. M. Martin's office.  
 Councilmen present Messrs Lenwood Borem, Madden  
 Ernst, and J. W. Bard. Mayor H. M. Martin, Presiding.  
 The Clerk being absent, on motion J. W. Bard was  
 appointed Clerk Pro Tem, The ~~Minutes~~ of last regular  
 meeting read and approved.

The Members elect of the new Council were now qualified  
 by Mayor Martin - viz: Edward C. Bard, R. McGirr  
 and John Watson, each being elected to serve for a  
 term of two years.

At this time the clerk, W. Rice came  
 in and took his place at the Clerk's desk.

The report of the clerk was called for, as to the  
 amount of funds on hand, in Treasurers hands, on 18th of  
 March. And reports that the Clerks and Treasurers accounts  
 are very nearly the same. And that on March 8th 1879

There was Cash in Treasurers hands, \$209.49

And that it is distributed among the various funds as  
 per statement from Treasurer on 31st page of the Journal.  
 H. Lenwood moved that the Clerks report be accepted  
 together with Treasurers report as given at last meeting  
 motion see by John W. Borem - vote on motion ayes  
 J. Borem, H. Lenwood, J. W. Bard, R. McGirr, E. C. Bard and  
 John Watson. The following communication was read &

read. - To the Hon Mayor & Council of Mt Union  
 Gentlemen, I herewith tender my resignation as a  
 member of the Board of Health.

 R. McGirr, E. C. Bard & John Watson.

The Appointment of a Street Commissioner being in order  
 The names of H. E. Judd, M. Madden & Col. Watson were suggested  
 as candidates - Mr Madden being present, withdrew his name  
 from being a candidate. H. Lenwood moved that  
 Harrison E. Judd be appointed Street Commissioner  
 for a term of one year. Seconded by J. W. Bard

The vote on motion of appointment stood as follows. Borem no.  
Linwood yes, E. Bard yes. J. W. Bard yes. Watson no. McGirr yes  
The Mayor declared the motion prevailed.

H. Linwood moved that John E. Ernst be appointed a member  
of the Board of Health for a term of 3 years. - Seconded by E. C. Bard  
Vote ayes Borem, Linwood, J. W. Bard, E. C. Bard, R. McGirr  
and John Watson.

Borem moved that Prof Geo W Clarke be  
appointed a member of the Board of Health for a term of 3 years,  
sec - by R. McGirr - vote ayes Borem, Linwood, J. W. Bard  
E. C. Bard, R. McGirr and John Watson.

Henry Linwood moved that David Fording of Alliance be  
appointed Solicitor for the Borough of Mt Union for the term  
of one year. - seconded by E. C. Bard - vote on motion  
Ayes Borem - Linwood, E. C. Bard, R. McGirr, J. Watson  
& J. W. Bard.

J. W. Borem moved that Henry Linwood and  
E. C. Bard be appointed the Committee on Streets for the  
ensuing year. - sec by J. W. Bard - vote ayes Borem  
J. W. Bard, R. McGirr & John Watson. Nays E. Bard &  
H. Linwood - motion carried

J. W. Bard moved that  
R. McGirr and John Watson be appointed the Committee on  
Side-walks for the coming year - sec by Linwood vote  
Ayes Borem, Linwood, J. Bard, E. C. Bard, R. McGirr,  
Nays Watson. motion prevailed.

Linwood moved that J. W.  
Bard and John Borem be the Finance Committee on  
Finance for the ensuing yr sec by McGirr - vote  
J. Borem No - Ayes Linwood, McGirr, Watson, E. Bard  
& J. W. Bard. Carried.

Borem moved that Linwood  
and Nestley Bard be the Committee to have in charge the  
Street Lights the coming year - sec by E. C. Bard.  
Linwood no. - Ayes Watson, McGirr, E. Bard,  
J. W. Bard and J. W. Borem - J. W. Bard moved that the Clerk  
be instructed to prepare an Ordinance authorizing the Levy of Tax for  
Municipal purposes for the coming year. seconded by J. W. Borem

Vote on motion Ayes J. W. Bard, C. C. Bard, J. W. Watson  
 Henry Linwood, John Boren, and R. W. Gurr —  
 on motion of John Boren, Council adjourned

Bond of St Commissioner

Know all men by these Presents:

That we Harrison E. Judd as principal, and Samuel Garrettson and J. N. Turner, as sureties, of the County of Clark and State of Ohio, are held and firmly bound, unto the State of Ohio, in the penal sum of Two Hundred Dollars, (\$200.00), for which payment well and truly to be made, we hereby jointly and severally bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, and administrators firmly by these presents. Signed and Sealed by us, this Eighteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and seventy nine.

The Condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas the said Harrison E. Judd, was on the seventeenth day of April, A.D. 1879, duly Appointed Street Commissioner of the Incorporated Village of Mount Union in the County of Clark and State of Ohio; now if the said H. E. Judd as such St Commissioner aforesaid shall faithfully perform the duties of his said office according to law, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
