

Regular meeting of Village Council held at Mayor Martin's office July 14th 1879.

Members present Councilmen John Boren John Watson, J. W. Bard, R. McGirr and H. Linwood, Mayor Martin Presiding. Proceedings of last meeting read and approved. The Committee appointed to prepare an ordinance prohibiting the playing of Ball on the streets & alleys, reported that the Solicitor thought there could not be a legal ordinance passed to prohibit Ball playing, and consequently had nothing to present to council. The Committee appointed to prepare a Schedule of Rates for a License Ordinance, reported through Mr Bard. Mr B. gave a report in writing, being substantially a copy of the Alliance Ordinance in regard to License. R McGirr moved that the report be accepted seconded by H Linwood. Vote Ayes. Boren Watson, Bard, McGirr & Linwood, motion carried — The report was not ordered filed, or deposited with Council. R McGirr moved that the Council pass a License Ordinance, and that clerk be instructed to prepare the ordinance.

Sec by J Mr Bard, Vote Ayes. J. Boren, J. Watson and J W Bard. R McGirr and H. Linwood. Motion Lost.

The following bills were presented viz: A bill of Melvin Guines for lighting 8 Lamps from May 8<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> 16 nights amt \$2.17. Including resetting lamp post.  
 2.40 also bill of \$2.40 for lighting Lamps 20 nights ending the 24<sup>th</sup> inst. A bill of H Guines & dated June 3<sup>d</sup> for two days labor in Cemetery @ 1<sup>50</sup> Friday \$ 3.00  
 3.00 And a bill for bridging a dam ditch near the Mills  
 1.25 & repairing Crossings, 1 days work \$ 1.25  
 J Boren moved the bills be accepted and orders issued for the payments of same from the proper funds. — The Clerk here reported that there is sufficient money to the credit of the various funds to pay the aforesaid bills. That is not otherwise appropriated. Mr. McGirr seconded,

The motion to pay the bills, vote on motion Ayes - Borem  
 Watson, Bard, McEirr & Lenwood, A Bill for Printing  
 by A. C. Davis for Board of Health, was presented, amount  
 275 - Two dollars and seventy five cents. McEirr moved to accept  
 and pay the bill from the proper fund, J. W. Bard seconded  
 the motion, vote Ayes J Borem, J. Watson, J W Bard  
 R McEirr, and H. Lenwood.

H. Lenwood moved  
 that the motion to change the position of the Lamp post at  
 Ernsts corner & place it on corner by Post office, as passed at  
 meeting on May 12th, be re-considered - motion sec<sup>d</sup>  
 by John Watson, vote Borem N<sup>o</sup> Watson yes,  
 Bard yes, McEirr no, Lenwood yes - motion carried,  
 John Watson moved to amend the original motion, so as to move  
 the aforesaid Lamp post, to the north far enough, so that  
 the light shall not be obstructed by the trees, sec<sup>d</sup>  
 by J W Bard - R McEirr now moved that the  
 amendment be so amended as to include the moving  
 of the Lamp-posts at or near Mrs Andrews and W. Judds  
 sec by Watson vote - Borem no - Watson yes, Bard no,  
 McEirr yes, Lenwood yes - carried - The vote on the  
 amendment as amended was as follows Borem no  
 Watson yes Bard yes McEirr yes Lenwood yes - Carried,  
 The vote was now taken on the original motion as  
 amended - resulting as follows, vj: Borem no, Watson yes  
 Bard yes, McEirr yes, Lenwood yes - motion prevailed

260 J. W. Bard moved to accept and pay from the proper fund a bill  
 to H. Grimes for \$2.60, for work done for B of Health department,  
 ("The B of Health having certified to it being correct and accept<sup>d</sup>  
 by the B of Health) Watson seconded the motion, vote ayes, Borem  
 Watson, Bard, McEirr & H Lenwood,  
 on motion of McEirr sec by J Watson council adjourned
